

STATE FOOD MONITORING PROGRAMS FOR PESTICIDES

Survey Date: July 1- 10, 2013

Survey of 50 state pesticide control officials, via Survey Monkey. Report compiled by Grier Stayton, Executive Secretary, Association of American Pesticide Control Officials.

Report Summary:

Total of 25 responses to 2 questions:

1) Does your state have a program which routinely monitors pesticide residues on food?

10 states replied yes (ND, CO, OH, NY, NJ, MD, HI, TX, FL, NC.).

15 states replied no (NH, VT, MT, SD, SC, NM, AZ, KS, AK, MI, ID, DE, NE, WY, IN)

2) If yes, is this program conducted by the state pesticide agency, food safety agency, Dept. of Health, or other?

- 4 state pesticide agency (CO, NJ, MD, FL)
- 2 food safety agency (OH, NC)
- 3 Dept. of Health (ND, MD, HI)
- 2 other (NY, TX)
