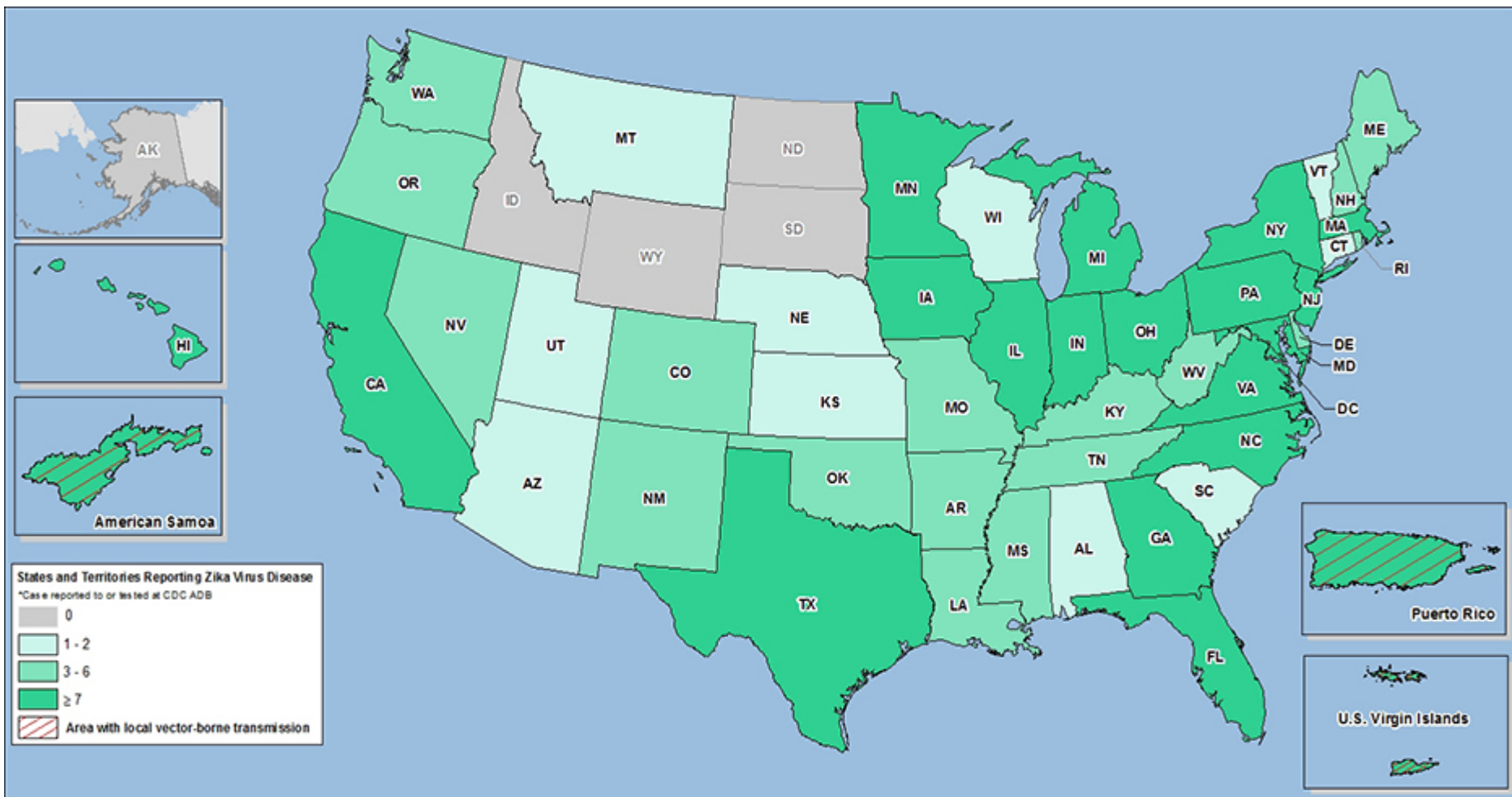
# Zika Virus:

## Disease and Congenital Infections

### Nationally Notifiable Conditions



- US States
  - Travel-associated cases reported: 691
  - Locally acquired vector-borne cases reported: 0
  - Total: 691
  - Sexually transmitted: 11
  - Guillain-Barré syndrome: 2
- US Territories
  - Travel-associated cases reported: 4
  - Locally acquired cases reported: 1,301
  - Total: 1,305
  - Guillain-Barré syndrome: 2

# NASDA Question to AAPCO/ASPCRO Leadership: *How can we assist?*

- NASDA contacted AAPCO and ASPCRO Leadership
  - NASDA was interested in the current activities being undertaken by both AAPCO and ASPCRO as they relate to Zika as well as state specific activities
  - Overview of pesticide regulatory programs of call participants (FL; WV; MD; and VA)
  - Interest was expressed in conducting a survey to collect information
    - Input from the Ad Hoc Workgroup as well as SFIREG
    - Coordinate and collaborate future activities of affiliate groups
  - Joint call with NASDA, AAPCO and ASPCRO Zika Ad Hoc Work Group
  - The survey is simply to collect information regarding how SLAs are involved not to get them more involved in any Zika response
  - DRAFT survey was shared with AAPCO/ASPCRO Boards of Directors, ASPCRO Zika Ad Hoc Workgroup as well as NASDA
  - As of June 13 2016, thirty five (35) responses have been received
  - Preliminary data only....

# JOINT AAPCO/ASPCRO SURVEY OF STATES

## SELECT QUESTIONS

- *Does your agency or state/tribe/territory have a statewide plan for Zika response?*
  - Yes – 41.8%
  - No - 23.53%
  - I don't know - 35.29%
- *Do you have the Aedes species mosquito (A. aegypti and A. albopictus) known to transmit the Zika virus within the borders of your state or territory?*
  - Yes – 37.14%
  - No – 37.14%
  - I don't know – 25.71%
- *Are there coordinated mosquito control activities in your state (for example, through a local mosquito control districts, county/city etc.)?*
  - Yes – 82.86%
  - No – 11.43%
  - I don't know – 5.71%
- Categories of certification:
  - General Pest – 44.12%
  - Public Health – 64.71%
  - Turf & Ornamental – 14.71%
  - Aquatic – 42.42%
  - Other – 38.24%

# AAPCO/ASPCRO SURVEY OF STATES

## SELECT QUESTIONS

- *Assuming a public health crisis which necessitates additional certified/licensed applicators to meet the demand for pesticide applications, does your state have an expedited certification process to address this type of situation?*
    - Yes – 42.42%
    - No - 39.39%
    - I don't know – 18.18%
  - *Assuming a public health crisis, does your state/tribe/territory have the authority to waive state/tribe/territory laws or regulations or adopt an emergency rule which would facilitate the application of pesticides?*
    - Yes – 51.52%
    - No - 21.21%
    - I don't know – 27.27%

# AAPCO/ASPCRO SURVEY OF STATES

## SELECT QUESTIONS

- *Has your agency seen an increase in pesticide businesses offering mosquito control services?*
  - Yes – 19.35%
  - No – 51.61%
  - I don't know – 29.03%



- *Has your agency seen an increase in pesticide products in the marketplace claiming to control mosquitoes?*
  - Yes, conventional products only – 11.78%
  - Yes, products exempt from federal registration (25b) only – 14.71%
  - Yes, both conventional and products exempt from federal registration – 20.29%
  - No – 38.24%
  - I don't know – 14.71%



# AAPCO/ASPCRO SURVEY OF STATES SELECT QUESTIONS

- *What additional resources do you need, if any?*
    - Outreach/education materials – 46.67%
    - Funding to conduct outreach/education – 46.67%
    - Funding for mosquito control activities – 30%
    - We do not need any additional resources – 20%
    - I don't know – 13.33%
