Dear Sir/Madam,

We are writing to you concerning recent, vague claims by Monsanto that it tested an unidentified number of unnamed glufosinate products in its internal lab and that an unidentified number of those products tested positive for dicamba in "initial testing." Monsanto has not identified the specific glufosinate products it tested, which of those products tested positive for dicamba (and which did not). Also Monsanto has not disclosed the sampling methodology, if the samples were sealed, acquired from a reliable source, and method of analysis, or the levels of contamination allegedly found. In addition, while Monsanto claims to have tested both products obtained from unopened containers as well as products obtained from sprayers and storage tanks, its allegations of contamination make no distinction between the sources. UPI considers Monsanto's generalized allegations of dicamba contamination reckless and irresponsible.

UPI does not manufacture or sell any dicamba products. UPI's Lifeline and Interline glufosinate products are manufactured in dedicated facilities that produce and formulate glufosinate exclusively. Accordingly, UPI has demanded that Monsanto provide the details above and confirm that its internal testing found no dicamba in Lifeline and Interline containers. Nonetheless, because Monsanto allegations are serious, UPI also is conducting its own testing to confirm that Lifeline and Interline are not contaminated with dicamba.
