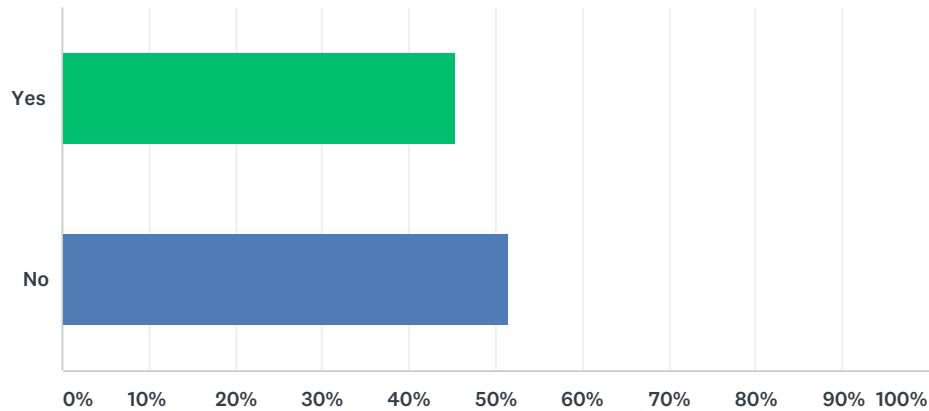


## Q1 Does your agency publicize any enforcement actions?

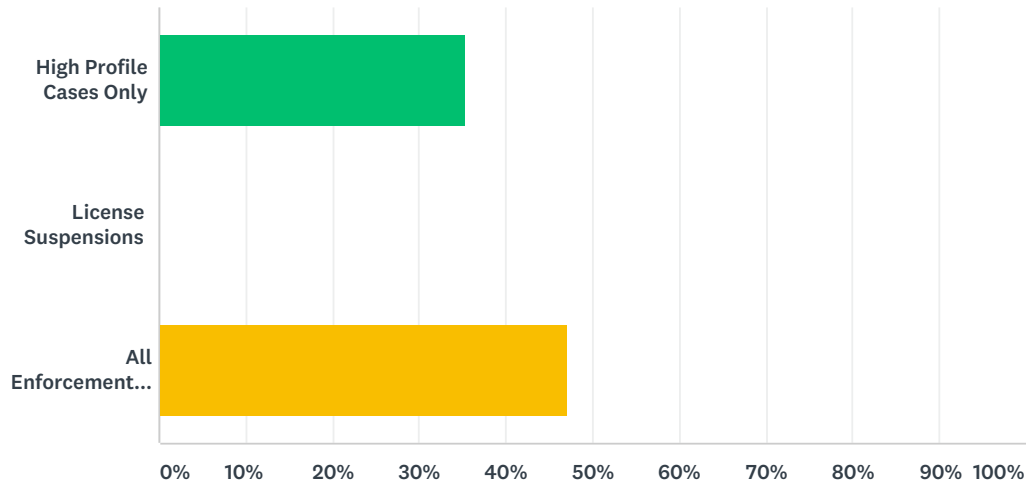

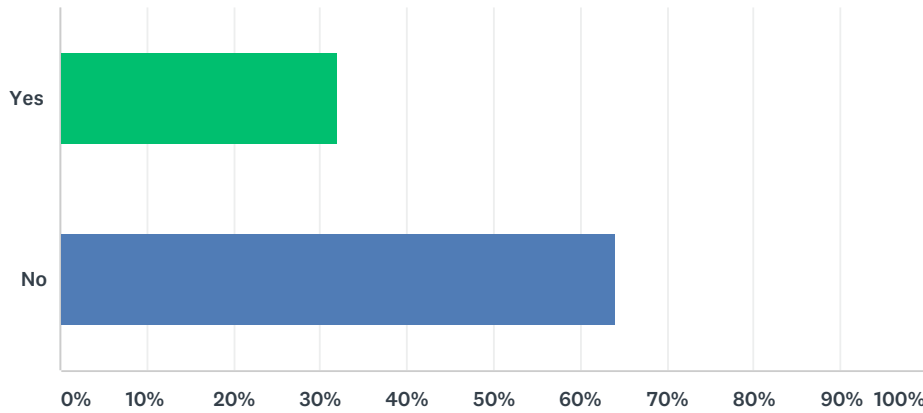

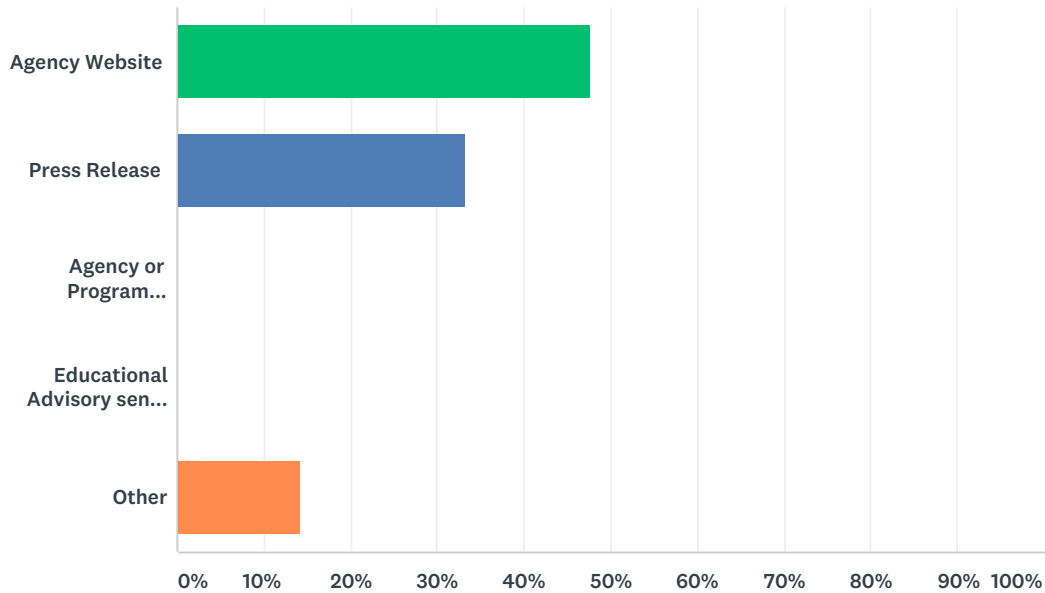

4	If an egregious case is publicized we include description of the incident, the violation or repeated violation, and type of enforcement action. If the case is beyond egregious then we will release the name of the party or parties involved to the media. For example, there was a farm that had repeated Worker Protection Standard violations which were basically ignored. After turning the case over to EPA the farmer was fined \$25,000 for their lack of any compliance with WPS.
