Issues have ranged from the inability to get applicators certified to the possibility of not having appropriate PPE. The lack of disinfecting wipes and the registrants ability to produce and then get them state registered, has been raised as an issue. All of us have more questions than answers. However, in each case the commitment of the various organizations to work together and to keep each other informed has been outstanding.

Information is changing rapidly, if not hourly. States are working around the clock to come up with novel ways to meet demands.
