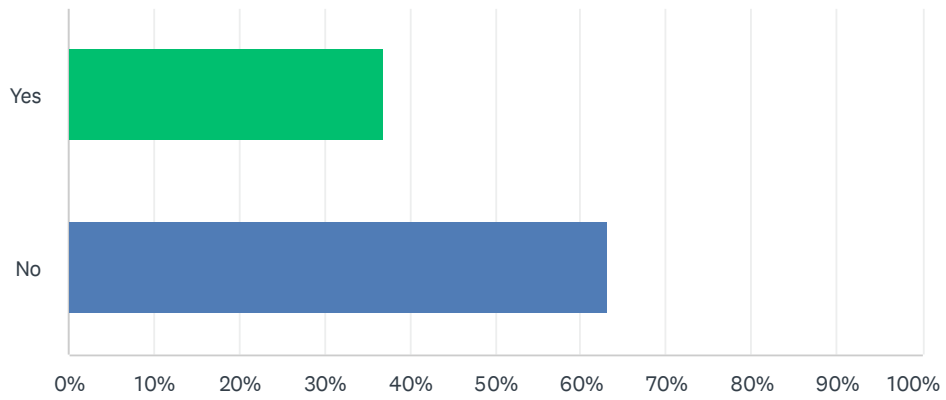

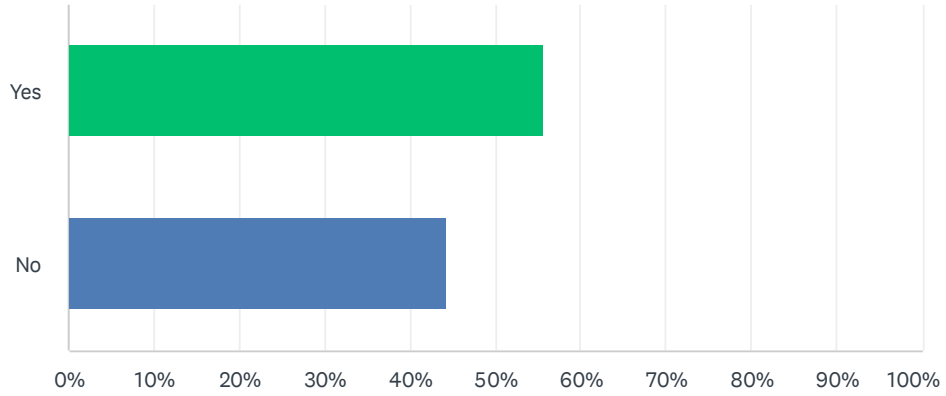

Q2 Does your state agency have guidelines to perform e-commerce inspections?

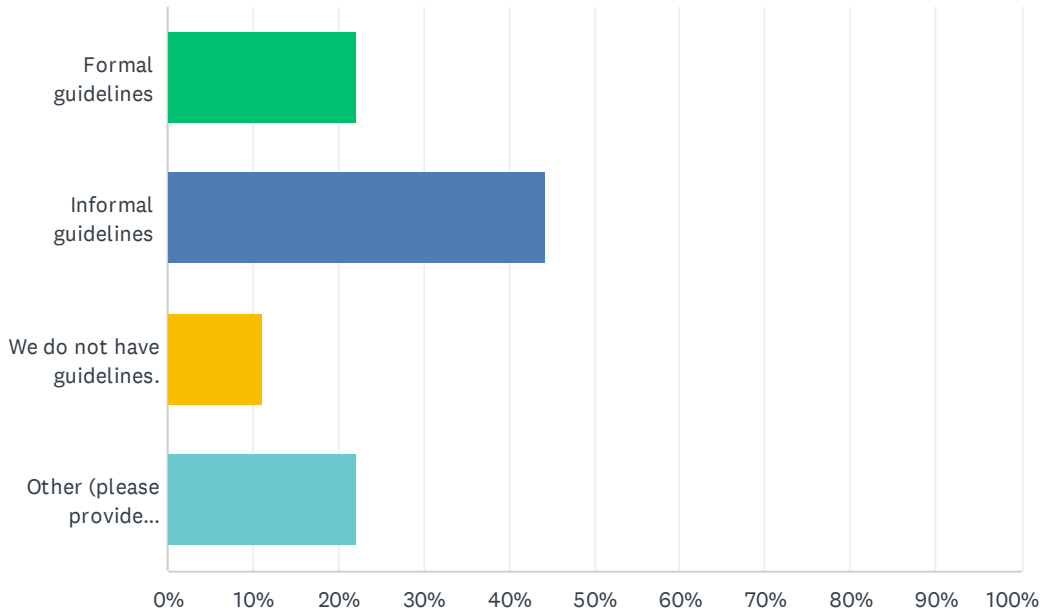

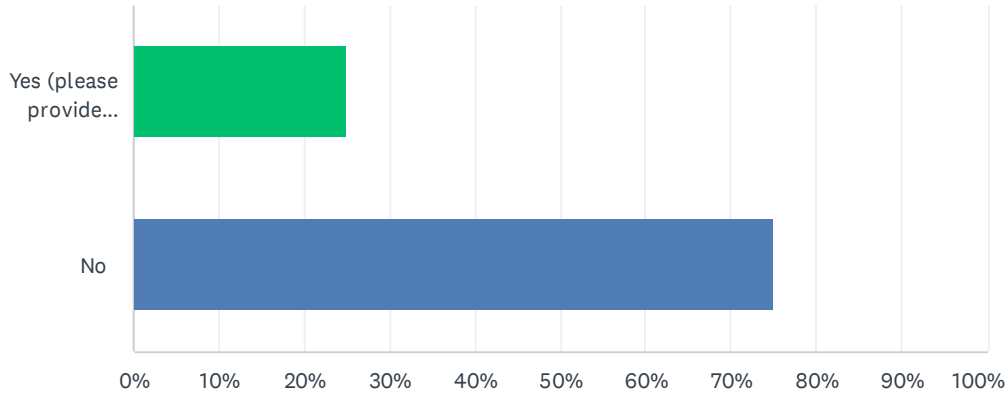

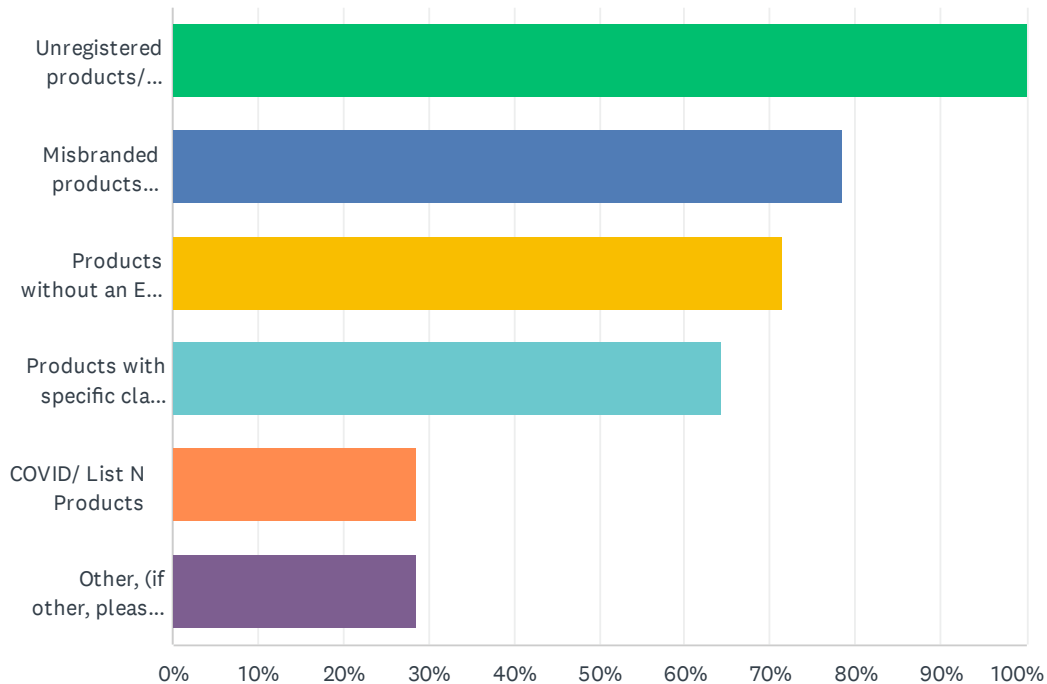

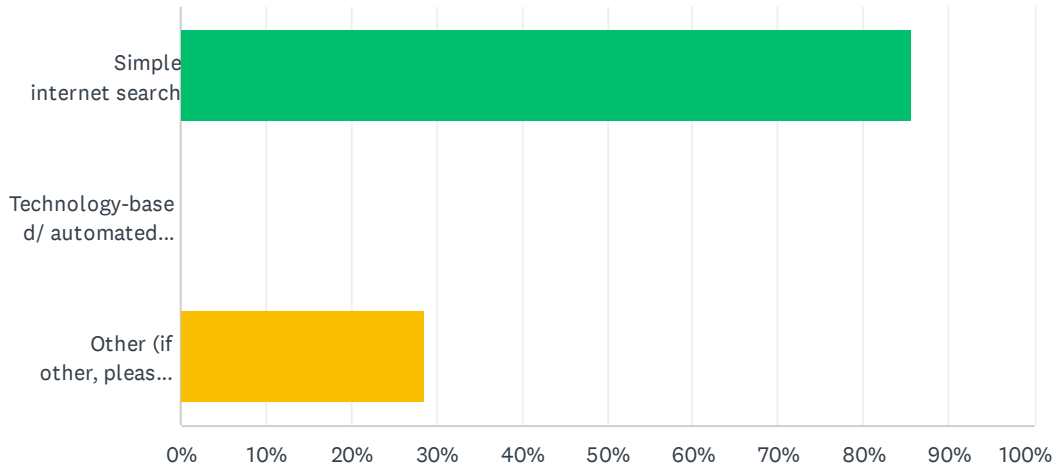

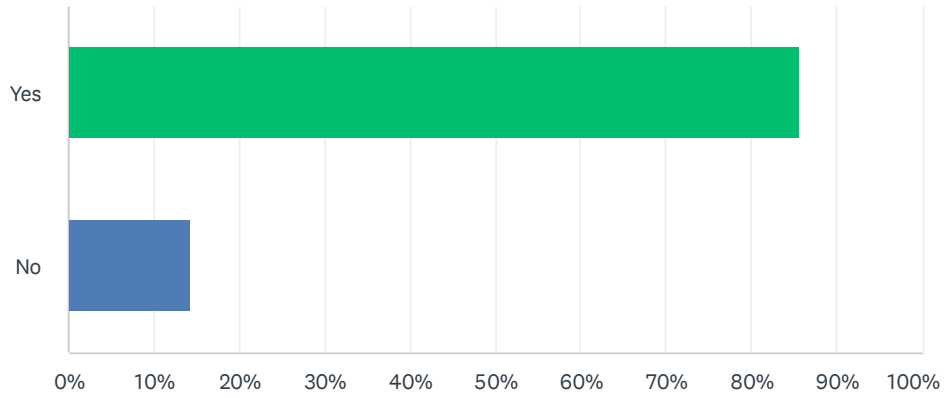

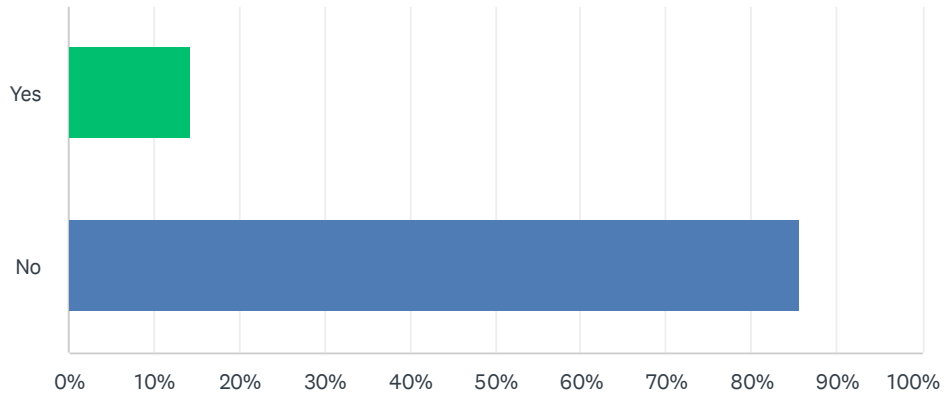

Q23 Has your state negotiated e-commerce inspections into your grant?

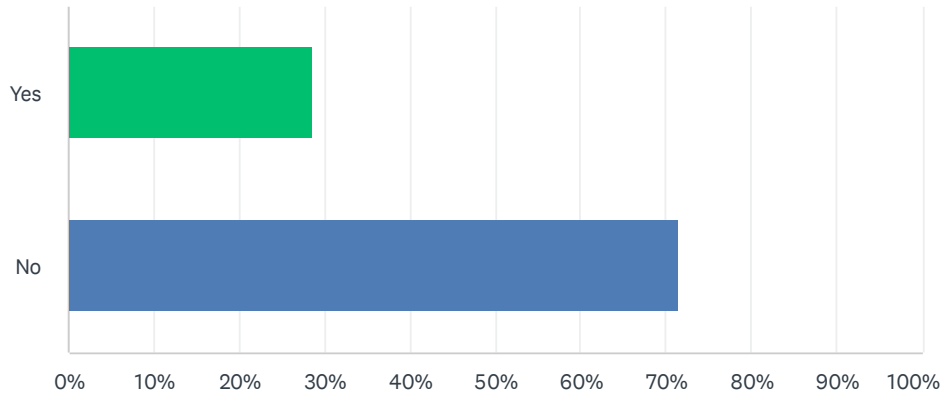

Q24 Has e-commerce inspections been negotiated into your reportable totals for marketplace inspections?

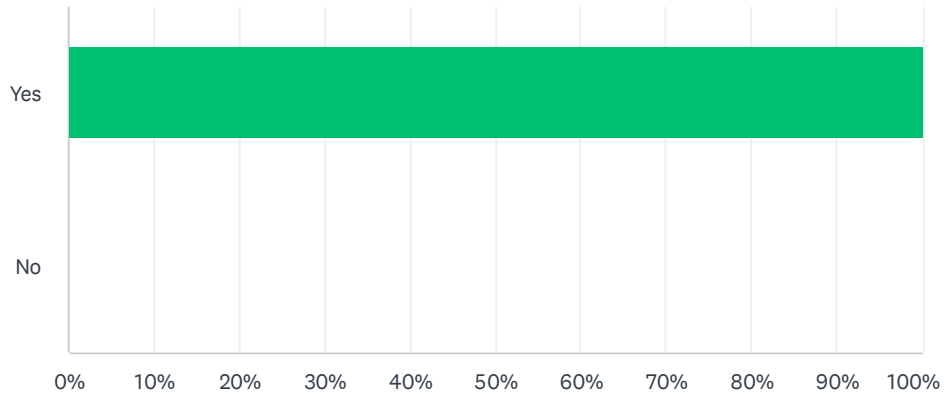

Q25 If you find that a product is not federally registered, does your state send the product information to your EPA region for action or follow-up?

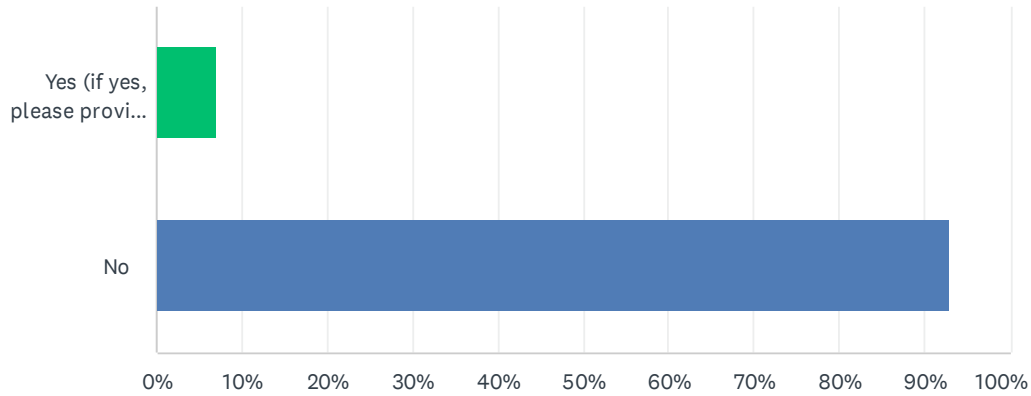

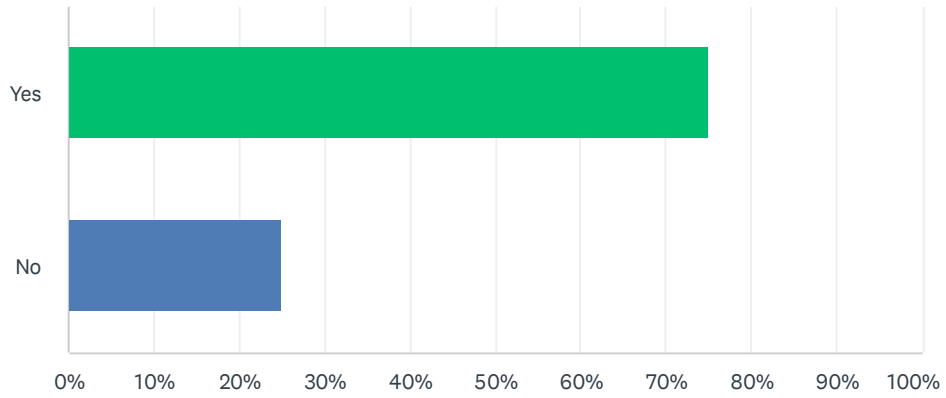

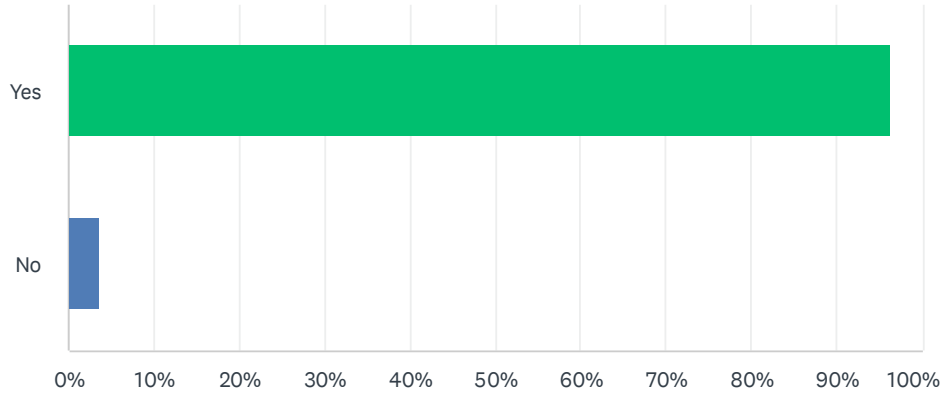

Q28 While your state does not currently do e-commerce inspections, would you find guidelines for completing e-commerce inspections helpful?

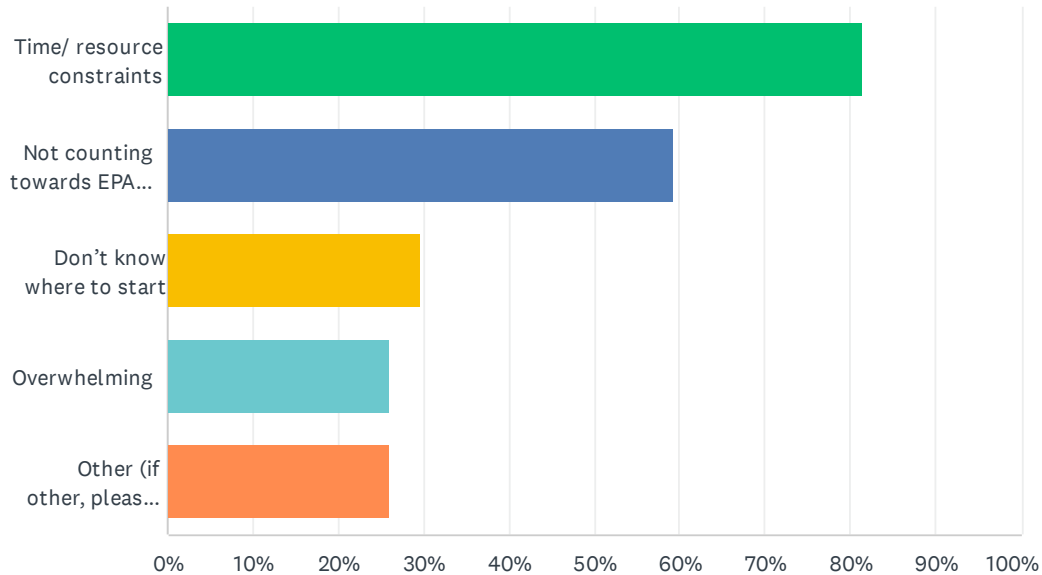
