

On Chlorpyrifos, the Agency is continuing to work as quickly as possible to process label amendments and cancellations. Information on federal register notices published regarding label amendments and final cancellation orders with existing stocks provisions as a result of voluntary cancellations can be found in docket EPA-HQ-OPP-2022-0223.

- EPA completed a PID for chlorpyrifos in December 2020. Now that the tolerances have since been revoked, EPA intends to evaluate the non-agricultural, non-food uses as part of the ongoing registration review for chlorpyrifos. Although a revised PID is expected in a few years, chlorpyrifos is expected to be one of the last organophosphates (OPs) to complete this round of registration review (ID expected in 2026).
- The FAQs for the chlorpyrifos 2021 Final Rule were updated on September 1, 2023.
- In regards to the OP petition, the Agency is reviewing the comments received during the public comment period, and does not yet have a date by which it plans to issue a response.
- In March of this year EPA released a response to the final report of the FIFRA SAP on the use of New Approach Methodologies (NAMs) to Derive Extrapolation Factors and Evaluate Developmental Neurotoxicity for Human Health Risk Assessment. This response can be found in the SAP docket (EPA-HQ-OPP-2020-0263-0057).
- In August, EPA implemented the Fish and Wildlife Service's nationwide final biological opinion for malathion. This BiOp is the first nationwide BiOp issued by the Fish and Wildlife Service to cover all registered uses of a pesticide across the US and its territories.
  - The implementation of this BiOp represents the final stage in the Endangered Species Act consultation for malathion.
  - In order to implement the BiOp EPA issued Endangered Species Protection Bulletins and approved malathion label amendments to incorporate measures to protect listed species.
- Also in August, EPA released the Acephate Draft Risk Assessments to the docket.
- EPA is reviewing and stamping/approving labels reflecting the early mitigation measures for diazinon, ethoprop, tribufos, and phosmet.
- Several other OPs are planned for DRAs and PIDs before the end of the calendar year or early in 2024 including, TCVP, malathion, dimethoate, dicrotophos.
- We are continuing to follow the OP schedule on the web and work toward more OP PIDs and IDs.
