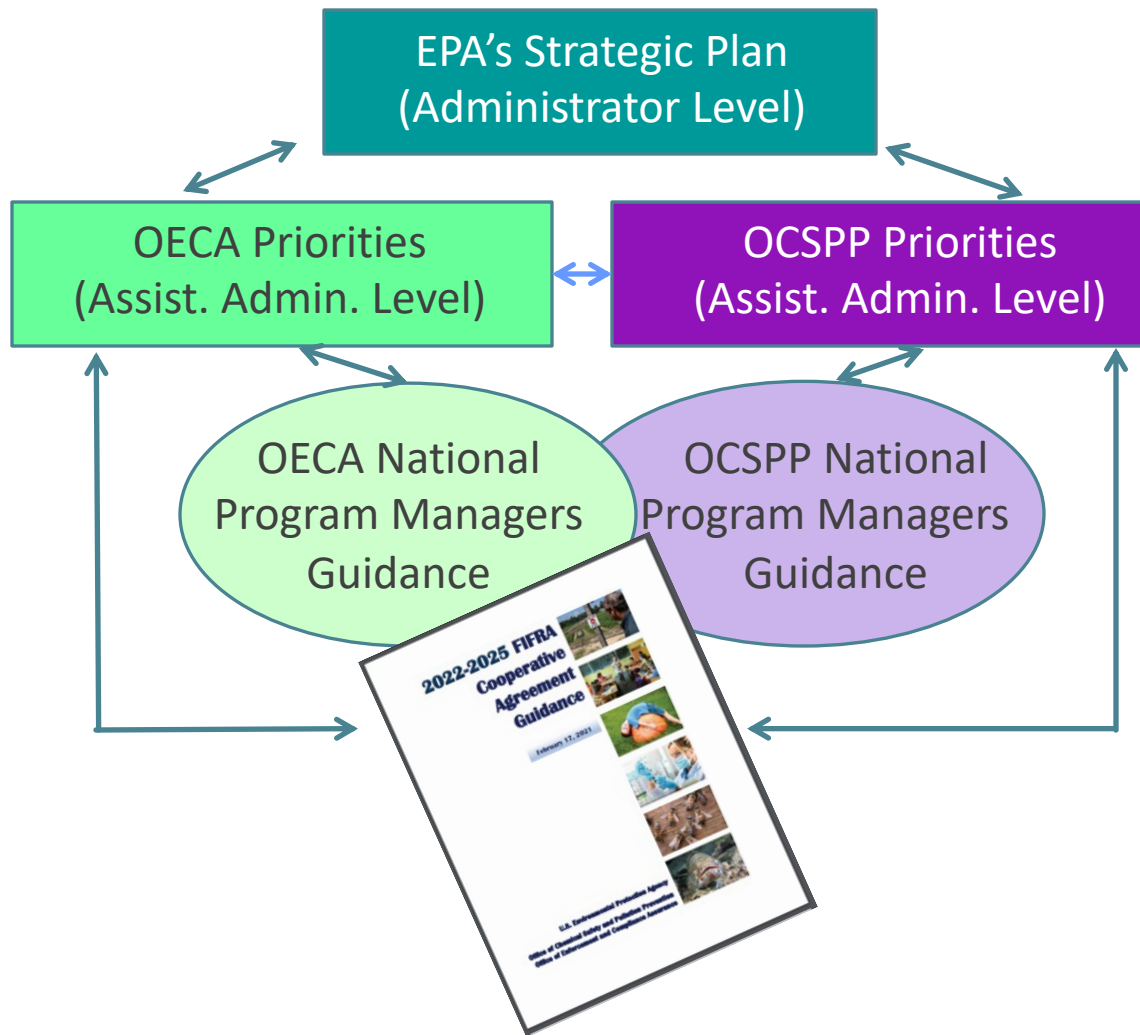

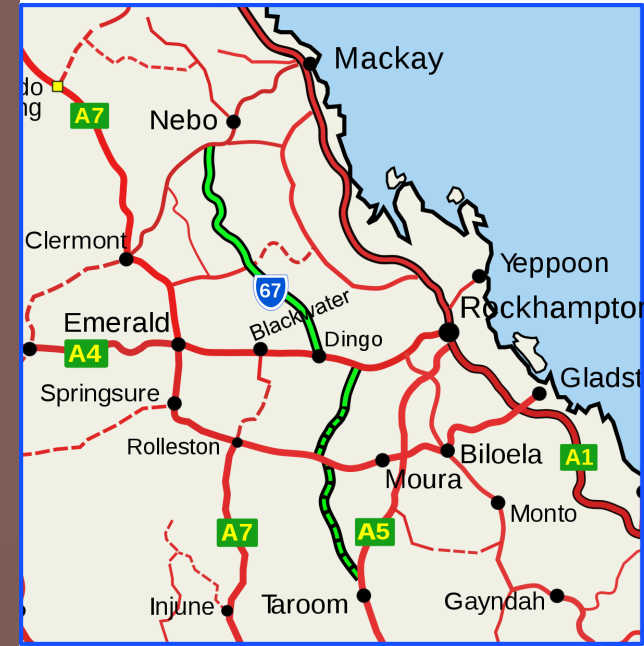

EPA National Priority Setting



Guidance Purpose

- Joint OPP/OECA guidance document
- Carries forward national priorities; considers regional, state and tribal priorities
- “Roadmap” for regions, states, tribes and territories to follow
- Lists activities eligible for funding and how these EPA funds should be used





Process Timeline

- **February-May 2024:** solicited input from OPP, OECA and regional subject matter experts as well as regional offices
- **May 2024:** Created initial “strawman” draft for regional review
- **June 2024:** Discuss regional feedback on first draft and revise as needed
- **Late-June 2024:** send out draft to coregulators
- **July-Oct. 2024:** Amended draft based on feedback
- **Nov. 2024:** Sent second draft of Guidance to regions, states, tribes and territories for review and feedback
- **Dec.-Jan. 2024:** final draft and management review
- **February 2025:** send out final version
