# Planned Improvements to BLT

## BLT "Advanced Resources" page

- Develop public API/Web Services
- BLT data download (easily download spreadsheets of AIs, etc. currently active in BLT, including option to filter this download by states/counties)
- BLT GIS Services (download the GIS shapefiles of PULAs currently in BLT)

## Transition of BLT phone to softphone format

- Improve response process for BLT inquiries

## Additional rich text formatting improvements

- Bold, italics, underlines, colored font, hyperlinks
- Spacing effects to break up long blocks of text (similar to bullet points)
