SFIREG

The State FIFRA Issues Research and Evaluation Group (SFIREG) is a committee of the Association of American Pesticide Control Officials (AAPCO), that provides a formal and transparent process for all state lead agencies (SLAs) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to work cooperatively in developing practical solutions to national pesticide issues.

Analyze

Significant issues are assigned to formal SFIREG working committees - made up of EPA and SLA officials - where a practical solution will be developed in a collaborative forum.

Implement

SFIREG works with EPA to implement solutions, fostering national consistency and clarity.
