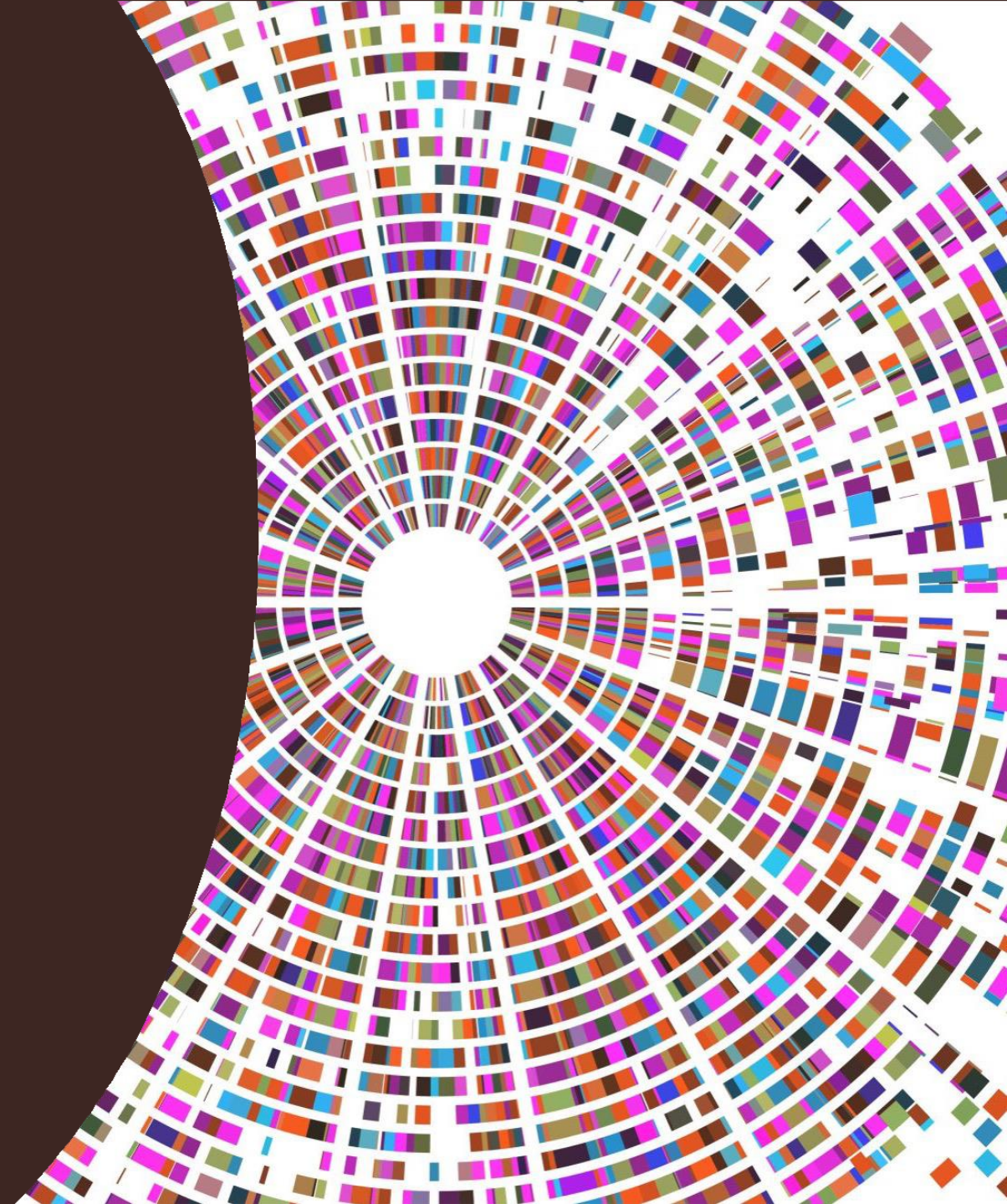

Introduction

Very often in the past the idea of recording the history of an organization has been left until it is too late. During the formative years and those immediately after, when emphasis is on progress alone, what has gone before is still well-remembered and borders on the commonplace. Suddenly there comes the realization that it is rapidly fading from mind, with the early records scattered - and the result is a compromise, or even a combination of fact and fancy which does not truly catalogue the group's existence.

The present review of the birth, growth, and prospects of the Association of American Pesticide Control Officials developed from an idea by the compiler, A. B. Heagy, with work started actively early in 1967. Conditions were then near-perfect for such a project. The Association had weathered the early storms, and was firmly established as a permanent feature of the American pesticide control picture. Most of the founders were still in vigorous life, and available for consultation. Records had been carefully preserved and for all practical purposes were complete. The facts so presented here are clear and incontrovertible.

This worthwhile project should be of great benefit to those younger members of the Association who were not privileged to be present when the foundation was laid down. They will be able to trace many of the guiding principles back to their introduction and follow their development logically.

Finally, it has been a source of pleasure - and some nostalgia - to review this material and recall again many of the incidents and facets which have unfolded through the years, together with the personalities who were so much a part of them.

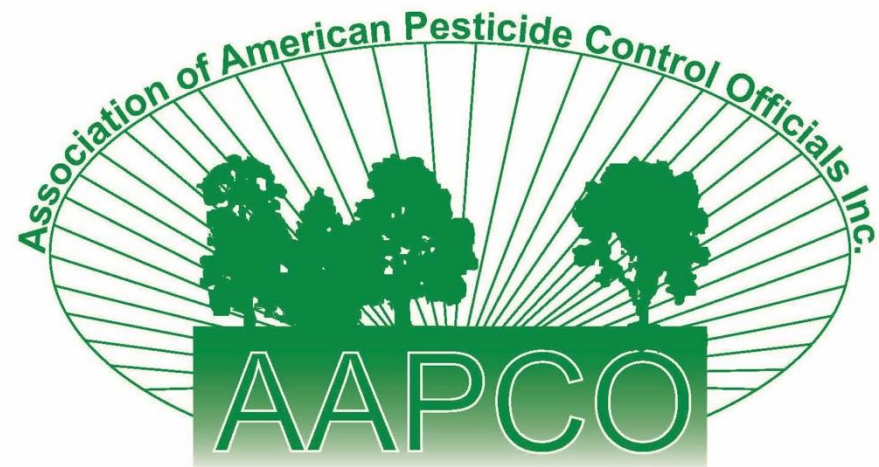
